**NOTICE OF CONFIRMATION OF AN ORDER
HIGHWAYS ACT 1980
ESSEX COUNTY COUNCIL
PUBLIC PATH DIVERSION ORDER 2024
FOOTPATH 25 HENHAM**

On 23 May 2024 Essex County Council confirmed the above order made under section 119 of the Highways Act 1980. The effect of the order as confirmed as shown on the order map will divert a part length of Footpath 25 Henham of unknown width shown by a bold continuous line on the order map commencing from a point at the private road known as Hall Close running in a north westerly then north north westerly direction through boundary features across a garden and along an access drive adjacent to Starr House/Garage for a total distance of 42 metres to the point where it meets the publicly maintainable highway known as Starr Road, to an alternative route 2 meters in width commencing at the aforementioned start point running in generally northerly direction along the private road known as Hall Close for a total distance of 53 metres to a point where it connects to the publicly maintainable carriageway known as High Street.

Copies of the order and order map can be requested to be posted or viewed by emailing publicpathorders@essexhighways.org to arrange a suitable time to inspect the documents quoting the Order title. Documents can be made available for inspection 8.30am-4.30pm Mon-Fri at Essex County Council, County Hall, E block main reception, Market Road, Chelmsford if so required following the current social distancing restrictions. The alternative route will come into force on 20 June 2024 and the old route shall be stopped up with effect from 27 June 2024, but if a person aggrieved by the orders wants to question their validity, or that of any provision contained in them, on the ground that it is not within the powers of the Highways Act 1980, as amended, or on the ground that any requirement of the Act, as amended, or of any regulation made under the Act has not been complied with in relation to the Orders, he or she may, under paragraph 2 of Schedule 2 to the Act as applied by paragraph 5 of Schedule 6 to the Act, within 6 weeks from 6 June 2024 make an application to the High Court.
